DIET AND FASTING	<p>On the day of your procedure</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For the morning procedure - do not eat anything from midnight • For afternoon procedures, you may have a light breakfast (toast or cereal) prior to 6 am. • Do not eat any food – including gum and lollies. • You CAN drink WATER up until 2 hours before your admission time. • You may have your usual medication with a sip of water. 										

What is a Gastroscopy?

A gastroscopy is an examination of the upper digestive tract (the oesophagus, stomach and duodenum). To do this, they will use a long, thin, flexible tube containing a camera and a light to view the lining of your stomach in order to suggest the best course of treatment for you. This is a safe and highly effective diagnostic technique that is more accurate than x-rays and much simpler than exploratory surgery. You will be given a sedative so that you are not awake for the procedure.
